

PUBLIC NOTICE: RETURN SUBMISSION & PAYMENTS DUE 10 SEPTEMBER 2021 FOR:

- 1) Pay As You Earn [PAYE]
- 2) Withholding Taxes
- 3) Intermediate Money Transfer Tax (IMTT)

The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) hereby reminds all its valued taxpayers that the following returns and payments for the month of August 2021 are due on the 10th of September 2021.

1. Payments & Returns Due

- a) Employees Tax or Pay As You Earn (PAYE) Remittances [P2 Remittance Advice Form]
- b) Withholding Taxes / Royalties Returns [REV5 Form]
- c) Mining royalties REV 5C Form
- d) Intermediate Money Transfer Tax (IMTT) [REV5B Form]

2. How to submit the due returns?

All taxpayers are reminded of the following issues:

- ✓ All PAYE Remittances Advices (**P2 forms obtainable on zimra website**) should be completed in full and submitted through the ZIMRA e-services platform (http://efiling.zimra.co.zw).
- ✓ In the event that a taxpayer fails to submit the P2 form on the e-services platform, taxpayers are encouraged and reminded to proceed scanning and emailing the return to the relevant email address from the list below depending on the region the that taxpayer is in.
- ✓ All withholding tax returns (REV 5 Form) and IMTT return (REV 5B form), should be submitted via relevant email addresses as shown below

3. Currency of transaction

Taxpayers should ensure that **all taxes are remitted on time, in full and in the currency of transaction** through banks. The following link provides ZIMRA banking details to make payments: https://www.zimra.co.zw/profile/2037-zimra-bank-accounts.

4. Payment of taxes to ZIMRA

When making payments to ZIMRA, please ensure that the following details are provided and correctly captured so that the payments may be credited on correct account:

- i. Name of Company
- ii. Business Partner Number (BPN)
- iii. Tax obligation eg PAYE, Withholding Tax etc

5. OUTSTANDING RETURNS AND DEBTS

Taxpayers who are in arrears with regards to their tax obligations are required to settle the outstanding amounts or to engage their nearest ZIMRA Offices to discuss and agree on a way forward. ZIMRA urges its valued taxpayers to file their returns and pay taxes due **on time, in full and in the currency of transaction** to avoid follow-ups.
