



PUBLIC NOTICE:

Estimated assessments for unfiled tax returns in the old Domestic Taxes system

The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) has noted with concern that some taxpayers have outstanding tax returns in the SAP system. The Commissioner hereby advises all taxpayers to file all outstanding tax returns immediately in the old system, failure of which estimated assessments will be raised before migration of data to the new TaRMS system.

Tax Returns and Payments

Filing of all tax returns and payment of taxes in the SAP system has been extended and taxpayers will continue to submit their tax returns in SAP through e-taxes and e-Services platforms until **27 November 2023.**

Taxpayers who need physical assistance on filing of returns and TaRMS registration can utilise the ZIMRA Self Service Centres (kiosks and help desks) at every ZIMRA station. The **Kiosks in all ZIMRA** offices (except Mhlahlandlela Bulawayo) for this month of November, will be open from 8.00am to 8.00pm, to assist Taxpayers to submit their returns and onboarding onto TaRMS.

ZIMRA would like to appreciate all Taxpayers and the Public for their patience with the Authority during this transition period.
