



PUBLIC NOTICE: PAYMENT OF DUTY ON FUEL IN TRANSIT

The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) wishes to advise its valued clients and the public of the 2024 Mid-term budget pronouncement by the Minister of Finance, Economic Development and Investment Promotion relating to the payment of duty for fuel in transit to mitigate against transit fraud.

With effect from 10 August 2024 all fuel, petrol, diesel, paraffin and jet A1, in transit imported through ports of entry by road is now required to pay duty and levies on entry. The duty and levies will be refunded at the port of exit upon compliance with all the transit procedures, including submission of proof that the fuel has been exported.

Consignee's and/or their representatives should approach ZIMRA at the port of entry to initiate the fuel clearance and payment process. For the refund process, once the fuel has been exported they should approach ZIMRA at the port of exit to initiate the requisite refund process.
