



NOTICE TO OUR VALUED CLIENTS: IMPORTATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES AGED 10 YEARS AND ABOVE FROM THE DATE OF MANUFACTURE.

Please take note that in terms of S.I 54 of 2024 motor vehicles aged 10 years and above are prohibited from being imported into Zimbabwe, however in terms of S.I 172 of 2024 clients in the following categories may now import motor vehicles aged 10 years and above from date of manufacture.

1. Deceased estates (inherited motor vehicles)
2. One vehicle that qualifies under immigrants' rebate. imported by Diplomat returning to Zimbabwe from posting abroad.
3. Immigrant as defined by Customs and Excise Suspension Regulations (Statutory Instrument 257 of 2003) that is any person who is a resident of Zimbabwe and enters Zimbabwe on return after having resided outside Zimbabwe for a period of not less than two years or any shorter period as may be approved by the Minister and having owned the vehicle for more than 6 months.
4. Immigrant as defined in Customs and Excise (General) Regulations (Statutory Instrument 154 of 2001) that is Any person who enters Zimbabwe to take up employment or permanent residence; or as a visitor but remains to take up employment or permanent residence; or for the purpose of attending any educational institution or a returning resident who has been away from Zimbabwe for a period of not less than six months on government appointment or assignment or as part of government peace keeping force.
5. Antique, classic, vintage, and historic vehicles at least 25 years or older from the date of manufacture and satisfying the following characteristics:
 - i. Design and engineering: Representative of its era
 - ii. Originality: Retains most of its original features
 - iii. Condition: Well-maintained or restored
 - iv. Rarity: Limited production numbers or unique features
 - v. Significant historical or cultural importance.

The vehicles exempted in 5 above will require an Import Licence from the Ministry of Industry and Commerce

All listed categories above must fulfil the necessary eligibility requirements as required by the Zimbabwe Revenue Authority.
