MIGRATION FROM PREPAYMENT ACCOUNTS TO PAYMENT AFTER ASSESSMENT FOR COMMERCIAL DECLARATIONS

The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority (ZIMRA) wishes to advise all registered Customs Clearing Agents, importers, exporters and the general public that the use of **ASYCUDA World Pre-Payment Accounts** will be deactivated with effect from mid-night 07 February 2026.

Payment of duties and taxes for all submitted commercial declarations shall be made through banks and other approved online payment platforms against an Assessment Notice, which is generated after the processing of commercial entries:

- For commercial transit entries clearing agent/transporter, proceed to make payments via bank channels
- For imports, excise, special excise and exports, the importer/ exporter/ client proceed to make payments via bank channels

All other procedures relating to the processing of commercial Bills of Entry shall remain unchanged.

Guidelines on the handling of declarations submitted **prior to 08 February 2026**, as well as guidance on the management of funds currently held in prepayment accounts, will be circulated to Clearing Agents in due course.
