CHAPTER 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Zimbabwe Revenue Authority requires prospective and reputable suppliers and service providers registered with the Procurement Regulatory Authority of Zimbabwe (PRAZ) under the below categories to submit the following requirements for pre-qualification for 2020 Standing List.
- 1.2 Bidders should be prepared to provide services on Purchase order (payment to be made after delivery of services).
- 1.3 All querries relating to the tender shall be made not later than 5 days before closing date of the tender. Any querries in relation to this RFP must be made in writing and addressed to the Director Procurement on procurement@zimra.co.zw.
- 1.4 Should you wish to respond to the tender, three copies of your proposal must be delivered to Zimbabwe Revenue Authority by the closing date and time advertised. Clearly mark the original document 'Original'.
- 1.5 Once approved, a company shall remain on the Standing List for the services approved, subject to renewal annually.
- 1.6 Additional guidelines with respect to the procedure for renewal shall be communicated in writing by ZIMRA.

1.7 Mandatory Requirements

- 9. Health certificate.
- 10. Clearly state years of experience in the provision of similar services.

2.4 Means of acceptance:

Bids in the sealed envelopes shall be deposited in a tender box situated at the above address. All the bidders should record their bids in the tender submission register situated thereto, in the format prescribed in the register.

Bids should be submitted in **triplicate** with one (1) original copy marked "**ORIGINAL**" and two (2) copies each marked "**COPY**" All 3 copies should be in sealed envelopes clearly marked with the details of the tender, and should be deposited in a tender box situated at the above address. In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original will prevail.



2.5 Right to Reject:

The Procuring Entity reserves the right to accept or reject any proposal or to cancel the procurement process and reject all proposals at any time prior to contract award.

CHAPTER 4

METHOD OF EVALUATION

- 4.1 Applications shall be assessed for their compliance with Mandatory registration requirements including registration with PRAZ under the relevant category and compliance to technical specifications.
- 4.2 There is no bid bond or tender security required as the application does not involve costs and prices.
- 4.3 Inspection of the premises and samples will be part of the evaluation process.
- 4.4 Technical Evaluation Criteria (for provision of motor vehicle service, repair and maintenance of motor vehicles):

Proposals will be awarded scores out of the maximum number of points indicated below for each of the following criteria:

Specific Experience

[50] points

Key Personnel

[50] points

Total:

100 points

The minimum technical qualifying score required to pass the technical evaluation is 80 points.

Notification of registration results

All participants that meet the criteria for registration as a bidder set out in this RFP shall, after consideration and approval by ZIMRA in consultation with PRAZ be gazetted in terms of Section 15 (8a) of the PPDPA General Regulations.

Applications that do not meet the criteria set out in this document shall not be published and shall be informed.

NB: THIS TENDER IS OPEN TO DOMESTIC BIDDERS ONLY.

Corrupt Practices:

The Government of Zimbabwe requires that Procuring Entities observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. In pursuit of this policy:

the Procuring Entity will reject a recommendation for award if it determines that the bidders recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, coercive or obstructive practices in competing for the Contract or been declared ineligible to be awarded a procurement contract under section 99 of the Act; a definition of these terms is found in clause 1.9 of the GCC;

• the Authority may under Section 72 (6) of the Act impose the debarment sanctions under section 74(1) of the Regulations;



- in accordance with section 42 of the Regulations, submission of a bid will be deemed to be an undertaking on behalf of the bidder to accept the responsibilities described in clause 1.1 of the GCC; and
- Any conflict of interest on the part of the bidder must be declared.
