## Review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee

Section 54 of the Act provides for review by the Special Procurement Oversight Committee especially sensitive or especially valuable contracts. This requirement will be subject to this review; hence, at least two identical copies of the bid document are required. Where the copies are not identical, the contents of the bid marked original will alone be considered.

#### **Evaluation criteria**

The Procuring Entity's evaluation of a Bid will take into account, in addition to the Bid Price, the following criteria and methodologies.

Eligibility and Qualification Criteria

All goods and related services must have as their country of origin an eligible country, as specified in the Special Conditions of Contract.

#### **Technical Criteria**

The Technical Specifications Sheet details the minimum specification of the goods required. The goods offered must meet this specification, but no credit will be given for exceeding the specification. No alternatives to technical specifications given shall be accepted for evaluation.

#### Currency

The proposed award of contract will be by issue of a Notification of Contract Award in terms of section 55 of the Act, which will be effective until signature of the contract documents in accordance with Part 3: Contract. Unsuccessful Bidders will receive the Notification of Contract Award and, if they consider they have suffered prejudice from the process, they may within 14 days of receiving this Notification, submit to the Procuring Entity a Challenge in terms of section 73 of the Act, subject to payment of the applicable fee set out in section 44 of and the Third Schedule to the Regulations.

#### Right to Reject

The Procuring Entity reserves the right to accept or reject any Bids or to cancel the procurement process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award. process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award.

Corrupt Practices
