# Services to be performed, location(s) and other requirements

The services to be performed under the Contract, the location or locations where these services are to be performed, the times of performance and the manpower; equipment and other resources required and the supervising agent at these locations are stated in the Statement of Requirements in Part 2. Bidders must signify their acceptance of these requirements when submitting their Bid.

The Supervising Agent will have authority on behalf of the Procuring Entity to give directions on the performance of the services and to approve satisfactory completion of these services.

The Bidder, at the Bidder's own responsibility and risk, is invited to a visit to inspect the site on 28 August 2020, at Mt Selinda Border post (ZIMRA OFFICE) at exactly 1100Hours. The costs of visiting the Site will be at the Bidder's own expense.

# Documents establishing conformity of services

To establish the conformity of the Services to the Bidding Document, the Bidder must furnish as part of its Bid a proposed methodology, work plan and schedule to establish that the services will be carried out in accordance with the required technical specifications and quality standards.

Standards for the provision of the Non-Consulting Services are intended to be descriptive only and not restrictive. The Bidder may offer in the Statement of Methodology, Work Plan and Schedule in this Part other standards of quality, provided that it demonstrates, to the Procuring Entity's satisfaction, that the substitutions ensure substantial equivalence or are superior to those specified.

# Eligibility and qualification requirements

Bidders are required to meet the criteria in section 28 of the Act and section 28 (1) of the Regulations to be eligible to participate in public procurement and to be qualified for the proposed Contract. They must therefore:

- 1. have the legal capacity to enter into a contract;
- 2. not be insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt or being wound up, not have had business activities suspended and not be the subject of legal proceedings for any Equipment AUTHORITY circumstances;

- 4. not have a conflict of interest in relation to this procurement requirement;
- 5. not be debarred from participation in public procurement under section 72 (6) of the Act and section 74(1) (c), (d) or (e) of the Regulations or declared ineligible under section 99 of the Act;
- 6. have the nationality of an eligible country as specified in the Special Conditions of Contract: and

- 8. In addition to these eligibility requirements, Bidders must demonstrate that they have the qualifications, resources and experience to perform the contract to satisfactory standards, as indicated in the Statement of Requirements.

Participation in this bidding procedure is open to both Zimbabwean bidders ONLY.

#### Validity of Bids

The minimum period that the Bidder's bid must remain valid is 90 days from the deadline for the submission of bids.

#### Submission of Bids

Bids must be submitted in writing in a sealed envelope to the address below, no later than the date and time of the deadline below. It is the Bidder's responsibility to ensure that they receive a receipt confirming submission of their bid that has correct details of the Bidder and the number of the Bid.

The Bidder must mark the envelope with the Bidder's name and address and the Procurement Reference Number.

Bids should be submitted in triplicate with one (1) original copy marked "ORIGINAL" and two (2) copies each marked "COPY" All 3 copies should be in sealed envelopes clearly marked with the details of the tender, and should be deposited in a tender box situated at the below address. 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#### Bid opening

Bidders and their representatives may witness the opening of bids which will take place at the submission address immediately following the deadline.

#### Withdrawal, amendment or modification of Bids

A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its Bid after it has been submitted by sending a written notice, duly signed by an authorized representative. However, no Bid may be withdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of Bids and the expiration of the period of Bid validity specified by the Bidder or any extension of that period.

#### **Bid Prices and Discounts**

The prices and discounts quoted by the Bidder in the Bid Submission Form and in the Price Schedules must conform to the requirements specified in the Price Schedule included in Part 2: Statement of Requirements.

#### **Bid Security**

The Bidder must complete and sign a "Bid-Securing Declaration" using the form included in Part 2. Any bid not accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration, will be rejected by the Procuring Entity as non-responsive.

#### **Evaluation of Bids**

Bids will be evaluated using the following methodology:

- 1. Preliminary examination to confirm that all documents required have been provided, to confirm the eligibility of Bidders in terms of section 28(1) of the Regulation and to confirm that the Bid is administratively compliant in terms of section 28(2) of the Regulation.
- 2. Technical evaluation to determine their substantial responsiveness to the specifications in the Statement of Requirements;

Bids failing any stage will be eliminated and not considered in subsequent stages,

#### Currency

Bids should be priced in both the Zimbabwean Dollars and the United States Dollars. The currency of evaluation will be Zimbabwean Dollars and the currency of payment will be the Zimbabwean Dollars.

#### Award of Contract

Unsuccessful Bidders will receive the Notification of Contract Award and, if they consider they have suffered prejudice from the process, they may, within 14 days of receiving this Notification, submit to the Procuring Entity a Challenge in terms of section 73 of the Act, subject to payment of the applicable fee set out in section 44 of and the Third Schedule to the Regulations.

The contract will only be valid subject to payment of annual contract administration fees of ZW\$8000.00.

Right to Reject

The Procuring Entity reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid or to cancel the procurement process and reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award.

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#### **Corrupt Practices**

Service entry

The Government of Zimbabwe requires that Procuring Entities, as well as Bidders and Contractors, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of contracts. In pursuit of this policy:

- 1. the Procuring Entity will reject a recommendation for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the Contract or has been declared ineligible to be awarded a procurement contract under section 99 of the Act;
- 2. the Authority may under section 72 (6) of the Act impose debarment and other sanctions under section 74 (1) of the Regulations; and

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3. Any conflict of interest on the part of the Bidder must be declared.

The<br>performance guarantee must be delivered within 14 days after receipt by the<br>tenderer of the contract signed by ZIMRA. If the selected tenderer fails to<br>provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a<br>new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted<br>the next most economically advantageous, compliant tender. |
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
